Everyone worked together to make the show a success.

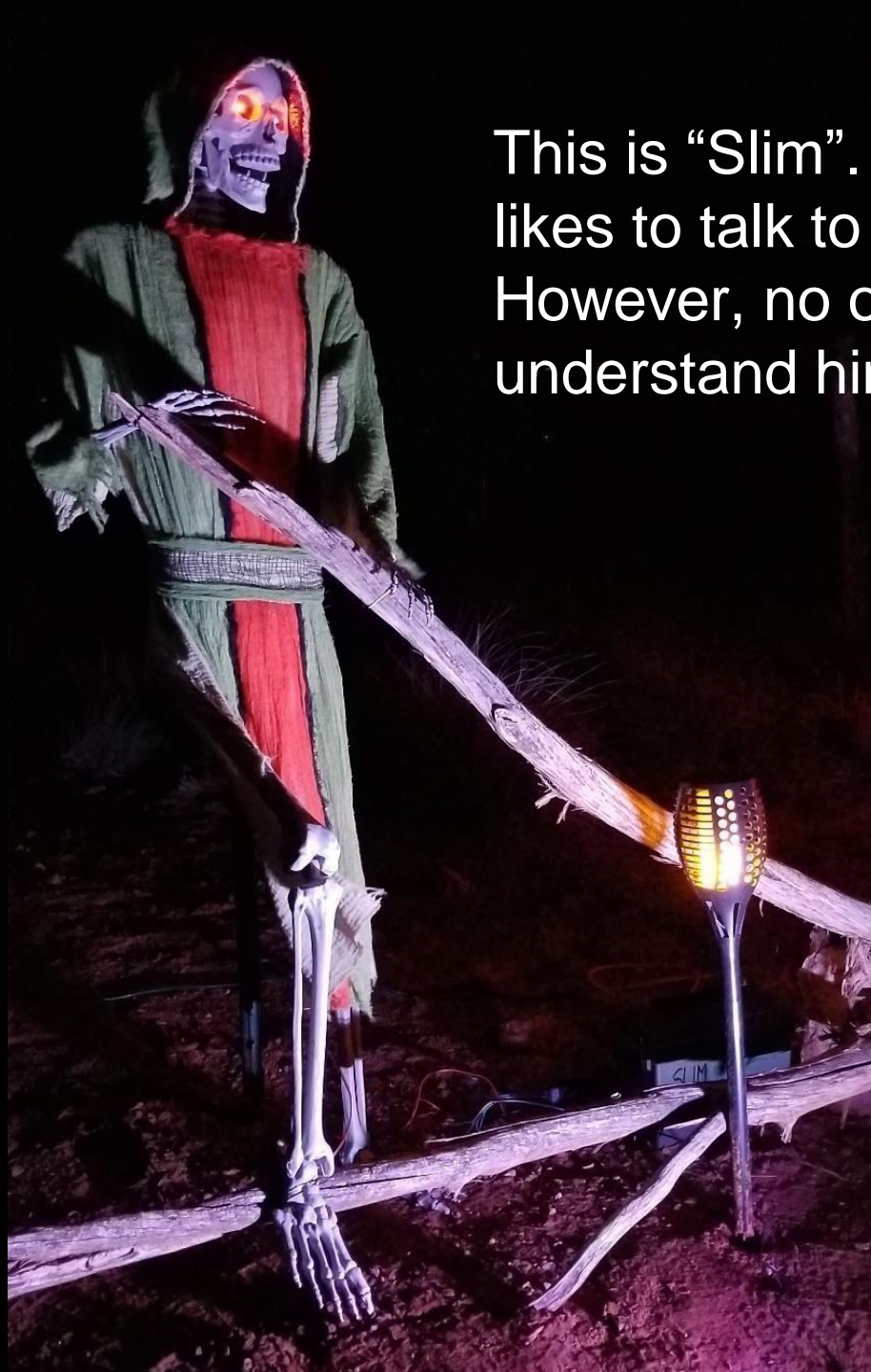
Everyone has returned to their “Regular Night Jobs” (very few have day jobs).

This is "Gravedigger". He is one of the "Stars" of our show.

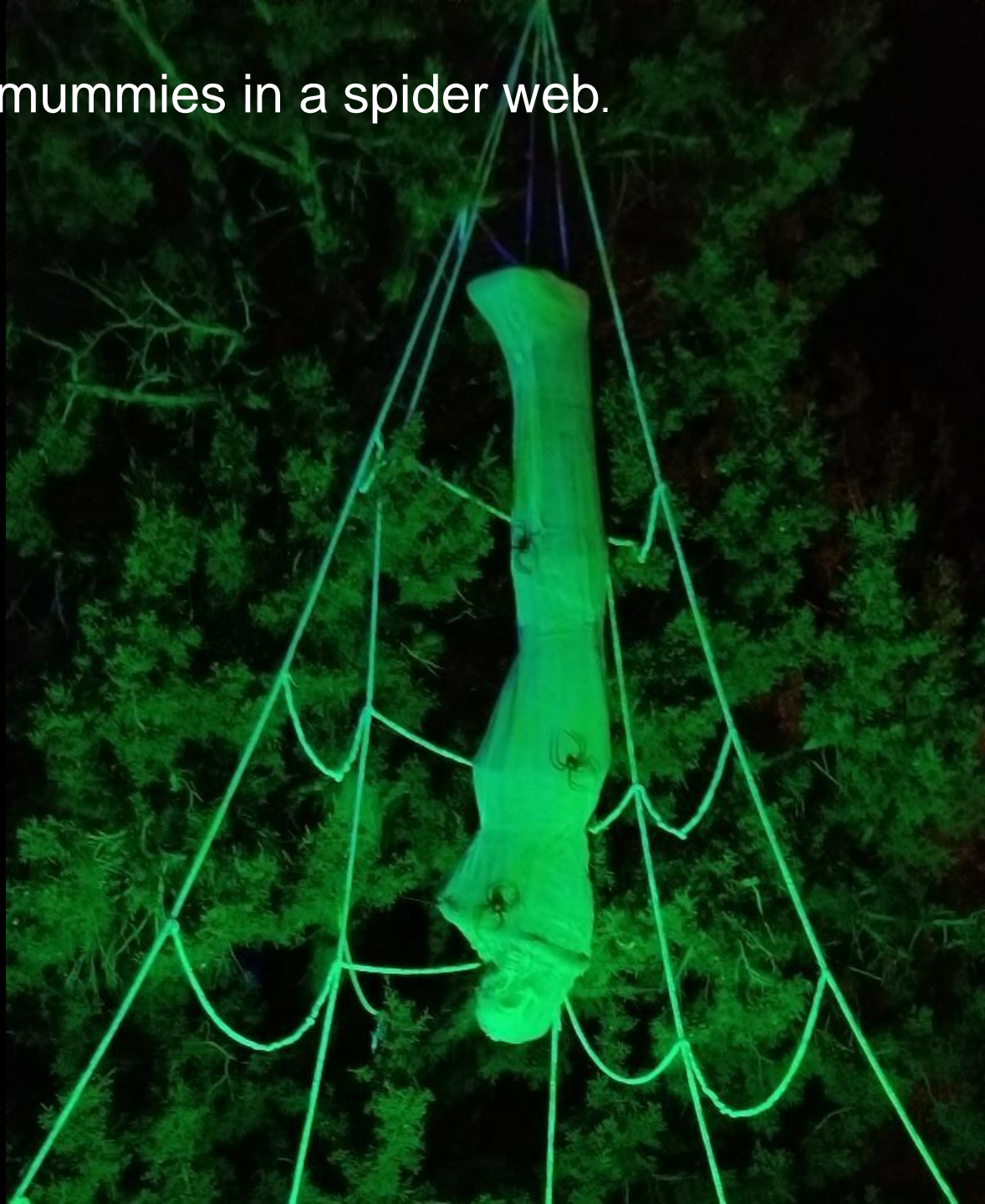
This picture was taken by JJ Williams. JJ is 12 years old. Thanks JJ!

TV show (boy are we old!).

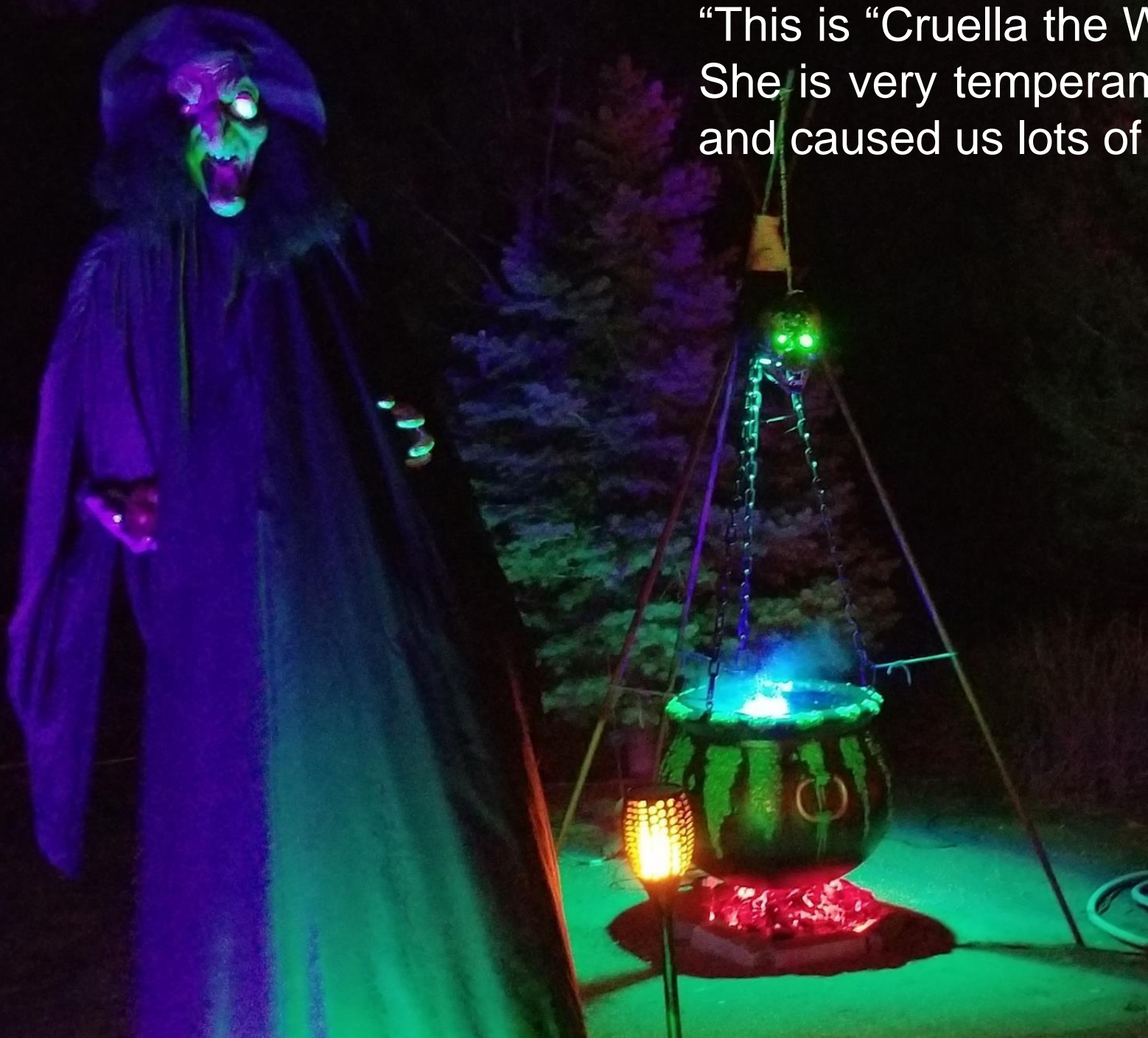
“Ghosts” These ghosts are made from paper lanterns covered with a white table cloth. There are two white LEDs in the top pointed down. The effect is pretty nice.

“Spooky Eyes” Nancy made these from cardboard boxes, painted black, with LEDs to provide the light.

“Mr. Crow with the Bulldog and Cat fighting”.

The dog and cat could hear the Skull and start fighting when the skull talked. Then the Skull would hear the fight and start again.
