Everyone worked together to make the show a success.

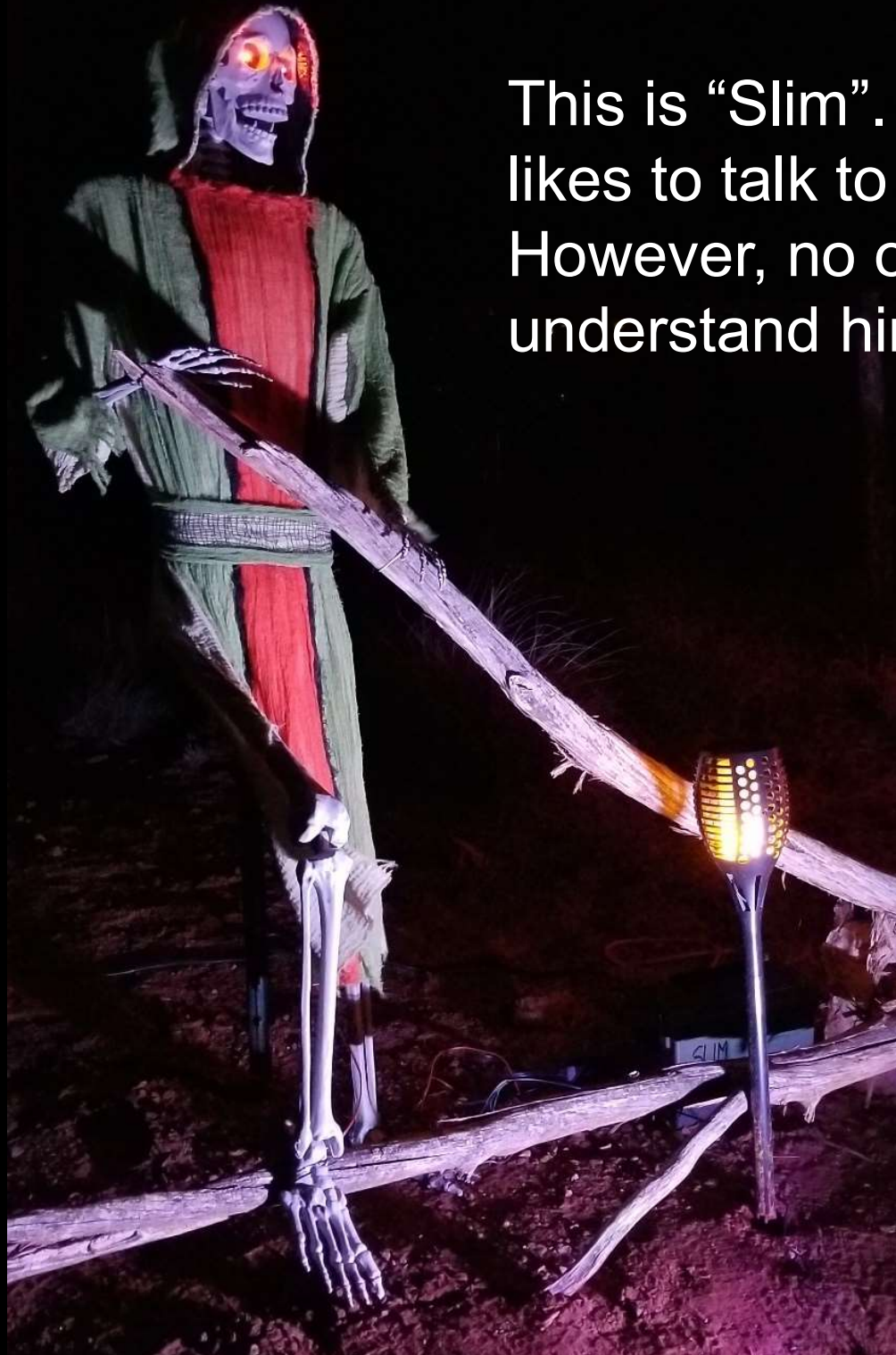
Everyone has returned to their “Regular Night Jobs” (very few have day jobs).

Nancy made the mummy that is hanging in the tree.



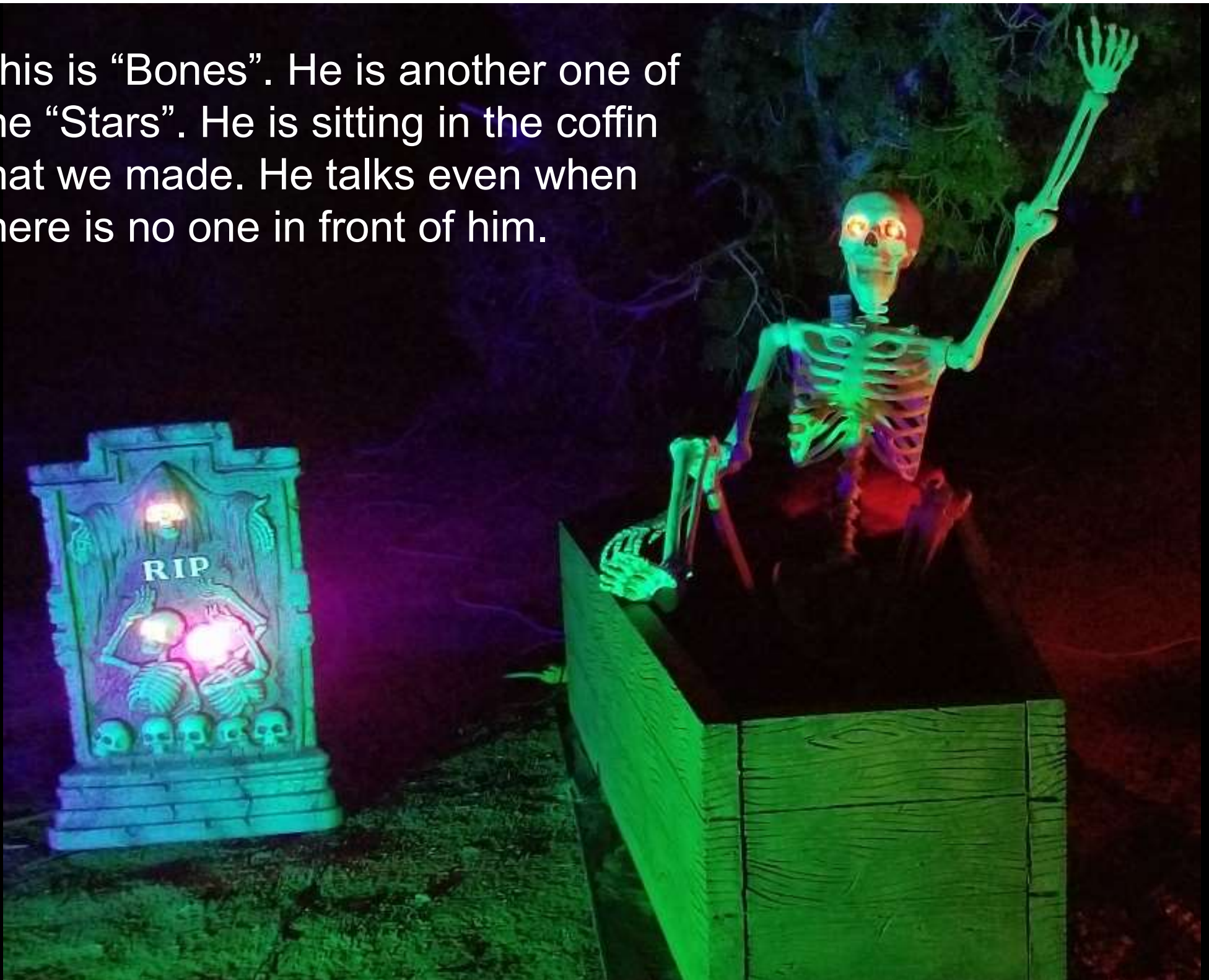
This is "Gravedigger". He is one of the "Stars" of our show.

and his cage.

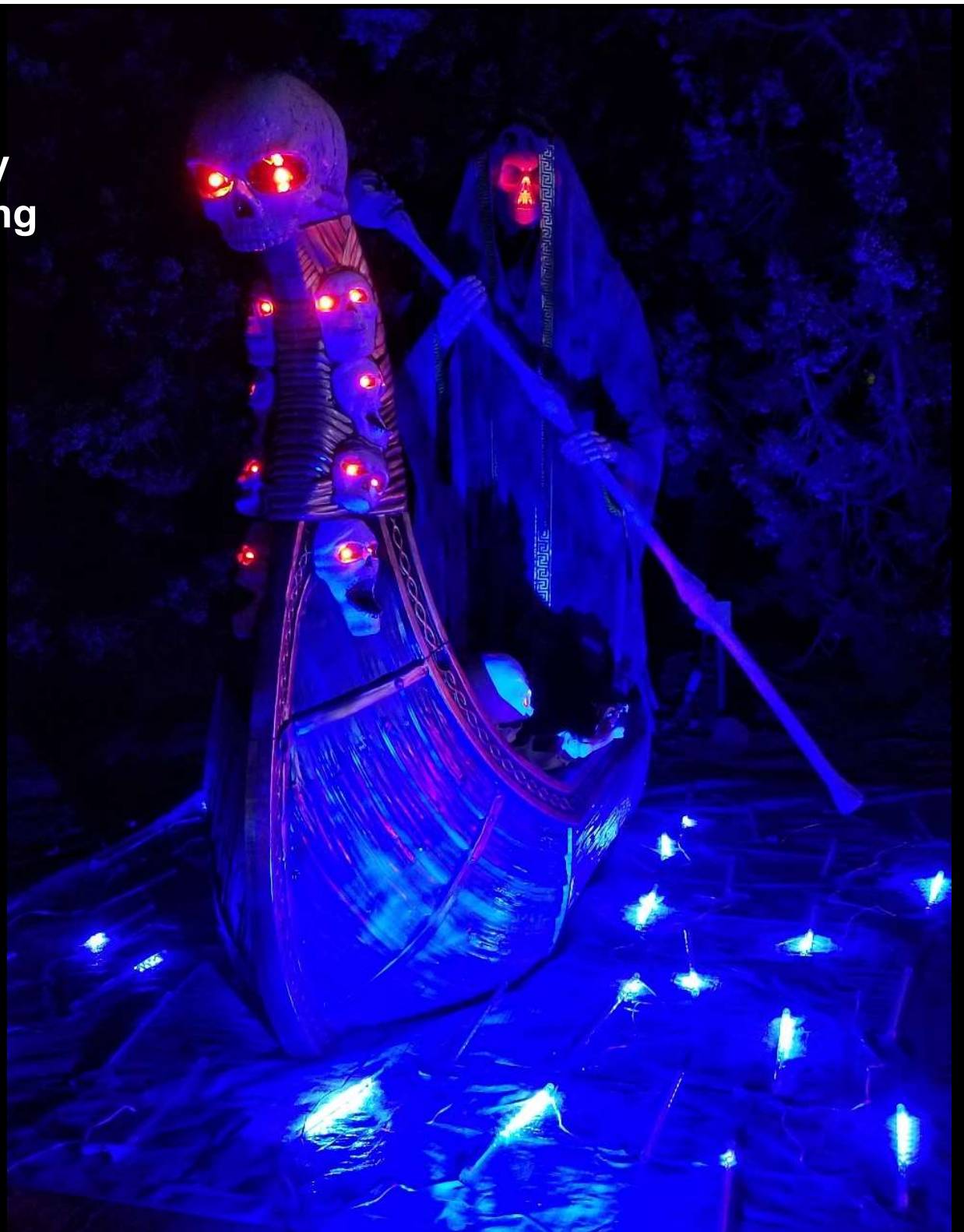


Another addition to the cast for 2022.

show.

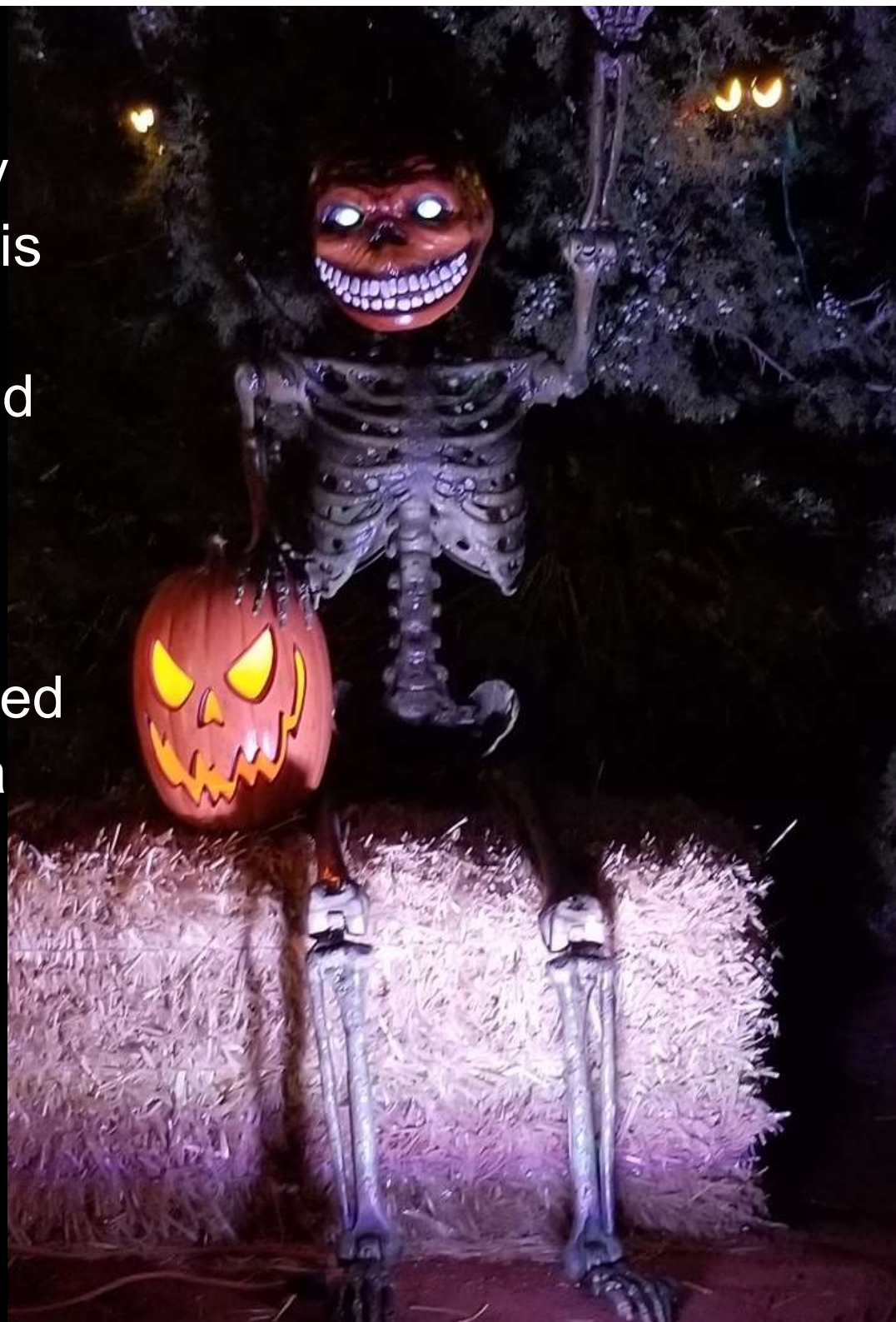


“This is “Druella the Witch’s

“Mr. Ghost” Every Halloween show needs lots of ghosts for extras. This guy has a great personality.



“Pumpkin Stack” is another new addition for 2022.

This is another ensemble cast.

They were able to stay balanced on each other through the whole show.





“Blazing Inferno” is another new addition for 2022.

Mr Inferno is over 12’ tall and is the tallest actor in the show. He doesn’t have a speaking part, but when you are 12’ tall you don’t need to talk to get attention.

“Spooky Eyes” Nancy made these from cardboard boxes, painted black, with LEDs to provide the light.



“Grim Reaper with Skull”
Another Grim Reaper that Nancy made is hovering over a double sized talking skull. This guy seemed to talk all the time. They were both great additions to the show.



“Mr. Crow with the Bulldog and Cat fighting”.
The dog and cat could hear the Skull and start fighting when the skull talked. Then the Skull would hear the fight and start again.



“Dragon and Knight” This skeleton wanted to “fight” the dragon. He talked Nancy into making the Knight costume, and finding a sword for him.



“Ghosts and Pumpkin”

These guys were not part of the main show. They were next to the road on the west side of the property.

We were hoping that they would lure the visitors into the yard (it seemed to work).
